Pet Rules & Etiquette

- 1. All pet owners are:
 - a. Eligible to bring a pet into the workplace subject to:
 - i. 30 days of employment
 - ii. Formal approval by the Pet Team
 - b. 100% responsible, 100% of the time, for their pet's:
 - i. Wellbeing
 - ii. Behavior
 - iii. Biological needs:
 - Scooping, bagging, cleaning, and sanitizing
- 2. All pets MUST be:
 - a. Owned and housed by pet owner for at least 30 days
 - b. Current on flea prevention treatment, as well as all vaccinations
 - c. Parasite-free (fleas, ticks, etc.)
 - d. Spayed or neutered
 - e. Obedient
 - f. Potty trained and of good hygiene (e.g., no foul, unpleasant or strong odors)
 - g. Positively controlled within the pet owner's immediate area:
 - i. Tethered (6ft or less), gated, or kenneled
 - h. Positively attended to 100% of the time
- 3. NO pet shall:
 - a. Exhibit aggressive behavior
 - b. Be disruptive to co-workers, and/or inhibit work productivity
 - i. Keep aisle clear and obstruction free
 - ii. No loud play
 - iii. No squeaky toys
 - iv. No meaty treats
 - v. Minimize scent distractions (keep food and garbage away)
- 4. Pet owners shall be respectfully attentive to coworkers who may be uncomfortable or distracted by the pet's behavior:
 - a. Proactively address distractions
 - b. Be open to your co-workers suggestions on how to improve distractions
